OVERVIEW:

The Johnstown Business Park is located in Richland Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania. The pristine 160 acre site is ideally suited for office, light industrial and warehouse/distribution facilities. All infrastructure and utilities are on-site, including digital fiber optic telecommunications. These light industrial parcels are shovel-ready. The park currently houses over 1,400 employees.

TRANSPORTATION:

The park is located within one mile of US Route 219 with access to the Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-76) and US Route 22. The John Murtha Johnstown Cambria County Airport (JST) is within three miles of the park, offering daily arriving and departing passenger flights. JST also offers general aviation services for public and private aircraft, including paved runways (the longest extending 7,000 feet), fueling, repairs, hangar space, and crash/fire services. JST is centrally located, no more than a 40 to 45 minute drive from anywhere in the region.


