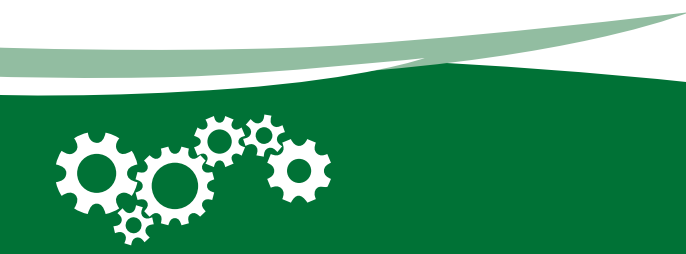

## ***Counseling Services***

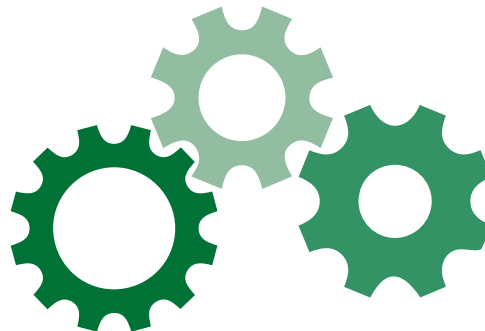
*JARI can provide assistance with:*
