



EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN 2022 PROGRAM GUIDELINES

The 5-month **EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN** Training Program is open to residents of Cambria County who meet the criteria listed below.

Other criteria are listed below:

- Status is unemployed, underemployed or returning Veteran
- Must reside in the following areas: City of Johnstown or Cambria County
- Must pass a background check, child clearances and be fingerprinted
- Must register with CareerLink system
- Must attend the orientation on August 22, 2022
- Classes are scheduled to begin September 12, 2022
- Must complete a minimum of 4 hours of community service once the course is completed
- *If the participant is a no show or exhibits chronic absenteeism, they will be required to reimburse tuition funds to JARI.*
