Our Phlebotomy Program will prepare you for a successful career. The program includes 40 hours of in-class instruction and laboratory work, covering essential topics such as:

- Universal precautions & safety
- Special collection procedures
- Handling & processing of specimens
- Anatomy & physiology
- Medical terminology
- Manual skills for venipuncture and skin puncture
- Didactic training to ensure quality specimens

Following your coursework, you will complete 100 clinical hours at a local hospital. Please note that clinical shift times may vary. Successful completion of these hours is required to be eligible for the national certification exam.

Certain additional requirements are not covered by the course fees. Hospitals mandate that students independently secure the following:

- Scrubs
- Malpractice insurance
- Background checks
- Physical
- Drug Screening
